ALBURY WODONGA WOODCRAFT SHOW

Two Members, Ian Pye and Fred S attended this show over the weekend of 3 and 4 May.

Ian reports that the show was successful and the local committee well pleased with the attendance and quality of exhibits. It was, of course not on the scale of the Canberra and Sydney shows with which we are so familiar. However, there were fifteen trade stalls, continuous demonstrations and some excellent exhibits.

The show was a combined effort of the Albury Wodonga Woodcraft group and the Australian Scroll Saw Association. The woodturning exhibits were not spectacular although there were some nice individual items. Mike Darlow would have found plenty of opportunity to comment on design aspects.

The show stoppers were the fretwork or scroll saw items, some magnificent intarsia and some excellent pyrography (the latter mainly by two local ladies). I hope my photographs do justice to the intricate workmanship of these items. If we ever get tired of turning, there are plenty of other woodie things to do but some that scroll sawing would test your patience.
